


Model 106-255 Modulated Carrier Signal Conditioner

DESCRIPTION

The COX Signal Conditioning System has been designed specifically for measuring turbine speed in turbine flowmeters, with an emphasis on low speed operation. As a result, fluid flow at low turbine speeds may be accurately measured without sustaining the significant turbine drag normally encountered in magnetic flowmeter transducer pickups. The carrier pickup is physically interchangeable with magnetic pickups. Meters must be recalibrated. Linearizing may be necessary at the factory. Additionally, the signal conditioner may be used to boost the output from pulse producing flowmeter transducer pickups, where the cable run from the transducer to indicator or ancillary equipment exceeds 500 feet. This signal conditioner pulse output is ideally suited for driving ancillary equipment such as controllers, totalizers, computers, and variable time base counters. In addition, the Modulated Carrier Signal Conditioner may be used as a dragless tachometer for measuring shaft speed, displacement, etc.
